Up to four (4) lines with  
28 characters per line.

**SAFEID IRON-ONS:** Use a DRY IRON (remove water) set to the hottest temperature and place shirt or fabric item on an ironing board with tin foil under the item's area to be pressed (this will help trap the heat because some irons do not get hot enough). Before applying the transfer onto shirt or fabric; place the shirt down flat and iron the area to remove any wrinkles. Place the transfer paper image side down onto the shirt or fabric item and iron the back of the transfer/image for a few seconds and let cool. Quickly peel the transfer starting at the corner immediately after the ironing process. USE CAUTION, paper will be hot. Complete applying and washing instructions will be included in Kit.

**HIGH VISIBILITY SHOULDER PATCH IRON-ONS:** Iron-on patches are designed with the SAFEID4FAMILIES logo in a bright high visibility safety orange that can be ironed on sleeves of clothing of your choice; intended for children, individuals with special needs, disabled or elderly seniors and/or those challenged with limited mobility. Its purpose is to easily identify a loved one that may be lost or has wandered away.

**SAFESHOES ID** Follow the above IRON-ON instructions onto a piece of cloth, then glue to the underside of the shoe's tongue.

**ID (GI style) TAGS:** You may select one of the following: place on the person's wrist through their shoe laces, on a neck chain, on their belt or where ever it is comfortable. These ID tags are personalized with emergency contact information for quick and easy identification of your loved ones.



**DNA SALIVA COLLECTION:** Please be careful not to touch the cotton tip of the DNA swab. Simply brush the inside of the mouth and under the tongue for about a minute. The tip must be completely saturated with saliva. Lay swab on top of a sterile flat surface and let dry for approximately 24 hours. Place swab, (careful not to touch cotton tip) in a plastic (zip lock baggy) and then into an envelope with individuals information on outside of envelope (name, date of birth) and most importantly, date collected. Place sealed envelope inside freezer.

**DNA HAIR COLLECTION:** Collect at least 25 strands of hair or more. Hair follicles need to be attached so please make sure hair collected has roots attached. The best way to do this is to use clean brush (with no hair on it) and once you have brushed the hair remove the hairs that come out of the brush. Secure hairs in a plastic zip lock baggy .



**FINGERPRINTS: CHILDREN AND ADULTS** - Wash your child's or individuals hands with warm water and soap. Dry them completely. Wiping fingers with an alcohol swab and then drying them should prevent perspiration from being a problem. Make sure children or individual are calm. If tense, fingerprints often does not register correctly. Pull apart ink strip to access ink. Take hold of the child's or individuals right hand at the base of the thumb with your right hand. Cup your hand over the fingers, tucking under those fingers not being printed. Guide the finger being printed with your left hand. Press designated finger straight down on the ink strip, then straight down on the designated ID Sheet. Repeat step for left hand.
