- I. Take or find **PHOTOS** and (if available) videos of your family. Store in a safe, secure and immediate accessible place, (best option is online digital storage, e.g. SAFEID Online Album).
- II. Prepare a **COMMUNICATION** plan with your family, keeping it simple and readily available.
- III. Create **ID INFORMATION**, for all family members, produced in multiple and distributed, together with the necessary physical materials for live dog scent tracking and identification.
- IV. Learn about the **LOCAL RESOURCES** and how to use and access them in an unforeseen circumstance or emergency.

STEP I - QUALITY PHOTOS

When a loved is lost, the quality photos you can provide immediately to law enforcement and emergency responders are the most important tools to ensure a positive result. Here are some tips ensuring that you have the best kind of photographs available to emergency responders.

- **TAKE or LOCATE** updated quality photos and/or videos, the two most important characteristics of photos are recognizability and accessibility.
- **RECOGNIZABLE PHOTOS and VIDEOS**, full face, head and shoulders (looking directly into the camera), updated every three to six months (growth and physical changes) or wearing seasonal clothing. Hint: videos are favorites of the news services, fitting into their format
- **STORE YOUR PHOTOS and VIDEOS IN A SAFE, SECURE, ACCESSIBLE LOCATION**, preferably in a **FREE** online digital storage album, e.g. SAFEID Online Album, ensuring accessibility, at anytime, from anywhere with username name and password.

STEP II - COMMUNICATION PLAN

Your family members, especially your children and dependent adults, need to know what to do when unforeseen circumstances happen. Unforeseen circumstances can include anything from being delayed at work when you need to be picking up your children at school or real emergencies. A family communication plan serves that all your loved ones are “on the same page”, enabling contact with one another or where to go and wait at predetermined places.

STEP III - ID INFORMATION and PHYSICAL MATERIALS

SAFEID Card Designer (Form) is programmed to create as many multiple ID cards as you like, for all your family members, together with the completion of the Profile and Information cards for each of your loved ones, and utilizing the SAFEID Physical Materials KIT, instantly provides all the vital information and assistance to law enforcement and emergency responders. Hint: All these information should be stored within a online digital storage album.
